Standing Together Against Rape (STAR)

- 24-Hour/7-days-a-week Crisis Help Line/Sexual Assault Forensic Exams
- Victim Advocacy/Accompaniment to law enforcement, medical exam and court proceedings
- Crisis Counseling
- Pediatric and Adult Forensic Collection and Examinations
- Prophylactic treatment for STIs.

Frequently asked questions

Q: How do I get help?

A: One Place Family Justice Center is located at 530 S. Lawrence St., Montgomery, AL 36104

Q: Does it cost for your services?

A: All services at one Place are Free.

Q: Can I call to get help or make an appointment?

A: No Appointment needed. We strongly encourage you to come in for assistance.

Q: May I start the process of filing for a Protection from Abuse order (PFA)?

A: Yes, if you are eligible. We have onsite legal professionals to assess and assist you in drafting the documents you need.

Q: Can I make a police report or sign a warrant?

A: Police officers are available onsite. If there is enough evidence to sign a warrant, a city Magistrate is available onsite to help facilitate the signing of a warrant.

Q: May I bring my children?

A: Victims may bring children with them, as One Place provides a beautiful child-friendly playroom and waiting area while you receive services.

Q: Do you assist elder clients?

A: Yes. One Place can assist and provide case management and criminal prosecution services through the Montgomery County District Attorney's Office.

Q: Do you have services for human trafficking victims?

A: Yes. One Place can assist with case management services, including safe shelter resources.
